The Earth and Moon orbit the Sun		
The Moon and Sun are about the same size		
When it's summer in the northern hemisphere of the Earth it's winter in the southern hemisphere		
The Earth is nearer the Sun in the summer and further away in the winter		
Day and night are caused by the Sun moving around the Earth once every 24 hours		
The Sun is a star		
Everything we see in the sky at night must be giving out its own light		
The Moon appears to change shape because of the Earth's shadow falling on it		
The Moon is a satellite		
The Moon rises when the Sun sets		
An eclipse of the Sun is caused by the Moon stopping light from reaching the Earth		
Mars takes less time to orbit the Sun than the Earth
