

sunrise and sunset	a year in the life of the Earth
day and night	winter and summer
phases of the Moon	solar eclipse
lunar eclipse	the Earth is an example of a non-luminous object
the Sun looks quite small in the sky	when a ship sails towards you, you see the mast first
the Sun is a star	the Earth rotates on its axis
the Moon is a natural satellite of the Earth	in our Solar System all the planets orbit the Sun
the orbit time of a planet depends on how far it is away from the Sun	

Extension statements

the relative movement of the planets means that sometimes they are closer to Earth	the relative size of the planets in the Solar System depends on how far they are from the Sun
most of the planets lie in the ecliptic plane
